

ABOUT

The Summer School at Bahçeşehir University aims to introduce and examine the city of Istanbul with a special emphasis on the historical and cultural evolution of Istanbul throughout the centuries. Situated on the Bosphorus Strait separating Europe from Asia, Istanbul has long been one of the world's most fascinating and lively cities. The capital city of the Roman Empire in the fourth century, the Byzantine Empire until the fifteenth century, and the Ottoman Empire until the early the twentieth century, Istanbul is today home to many important cultural and historical sites.

PROGRAM

The program offers students a survey course (HIS 1001)
Students receive 100 hours instruction (50 hours lectures and 50 hours seminars & field trips) during the program
Lectures are held on weekdays between 10:00 am 01.00 pm
Seminars are held on weekdays between 02.00 pm-04:00 pm

Students who successfully complete the program will earn 6 credits and acquire a certificate of completion and those who wish to acquire credits are expected to submit a work-in progress portfolio representing their academic studies throughout the Summer School. The working language of the Summer School is English.

PAYMENT PLAN


A non-refundable downpayment of US \$ 100 for program tuition by 1 June 2010.




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ABOUT

Bahçeşehir University is a young and dynamic university located in the heart of Istanbul, a city which for centuries has hosted many civilizations and empires, and continues to creates its own history at the intersection of two continents. Turkish as a Second Language Program will provide you the opportunities to explore to the fullest the richness of the Turkish language as you journey in our campus and our vicinity; immersing yourself in art, history, culture and other wonders.

PROGRAM

The teaching program aims to give students comprehensive working knowledge of Turkish in listening, reading, writing and speaking. We will discuss the common grammatical structures that are used in spoken and written Turkish. Students will progress from sentence to paragraph to text in written Turkish. They will learn how to use Turkish in different types of communicative situations that they are likely to encounter. They will use the latest textbooks to gain the skills and confidence needed to use Turkish in every aspect of life: at work and in social situations. Pronunciation is also a major part of each lesson.

Students who successufully complete the program will earn 6 credits and acquire a certificate of completion.

Courses

The Turkish as a Second Language Program is conducted at two levels -elementary (TL1001 Intensive Elementary Turkish) and intermediate (TL1003 Intensive Intermediate Turkish).

At each level, we will work on the four language skills - listening, speaking, reading and writing.

- · Class size is limited to approximately 20 students.
- · Students receive 100 hours of instruction during the program.
- · Classes are held on weekdays 10:00 am 4:30 pm.
 - Grammar 10:00 am 12:00 am
 - Reading & Writing 1:00 pm 2:30 pm
 - Listening & Speaking 3:00 pm 4:30 pm

Course sessions are interesting, lively and informative. Discussion is encouraged and students are given opportunities to use Turkish to express their opinions. They will also engage in role-plays, debates, skits and language games.
